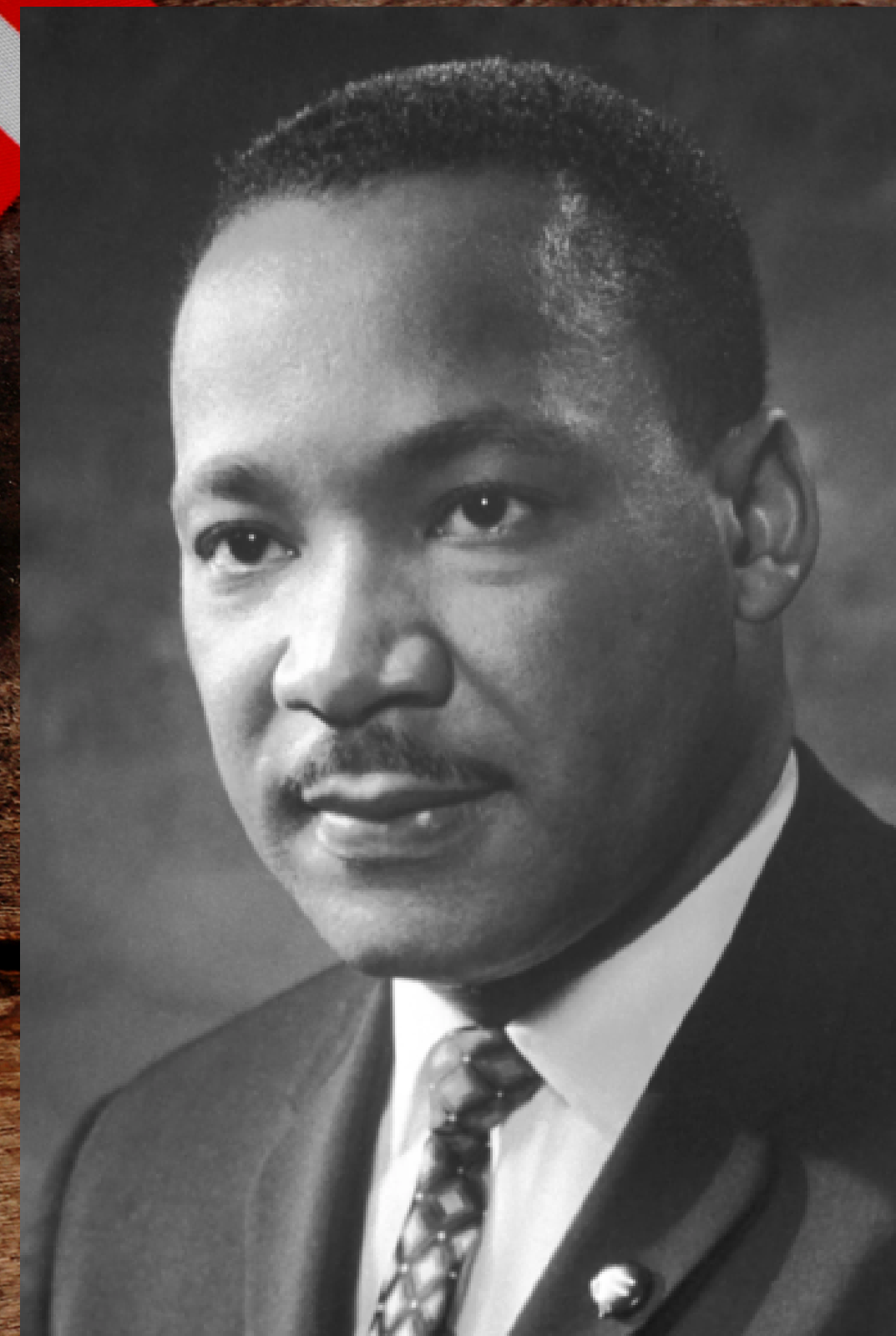

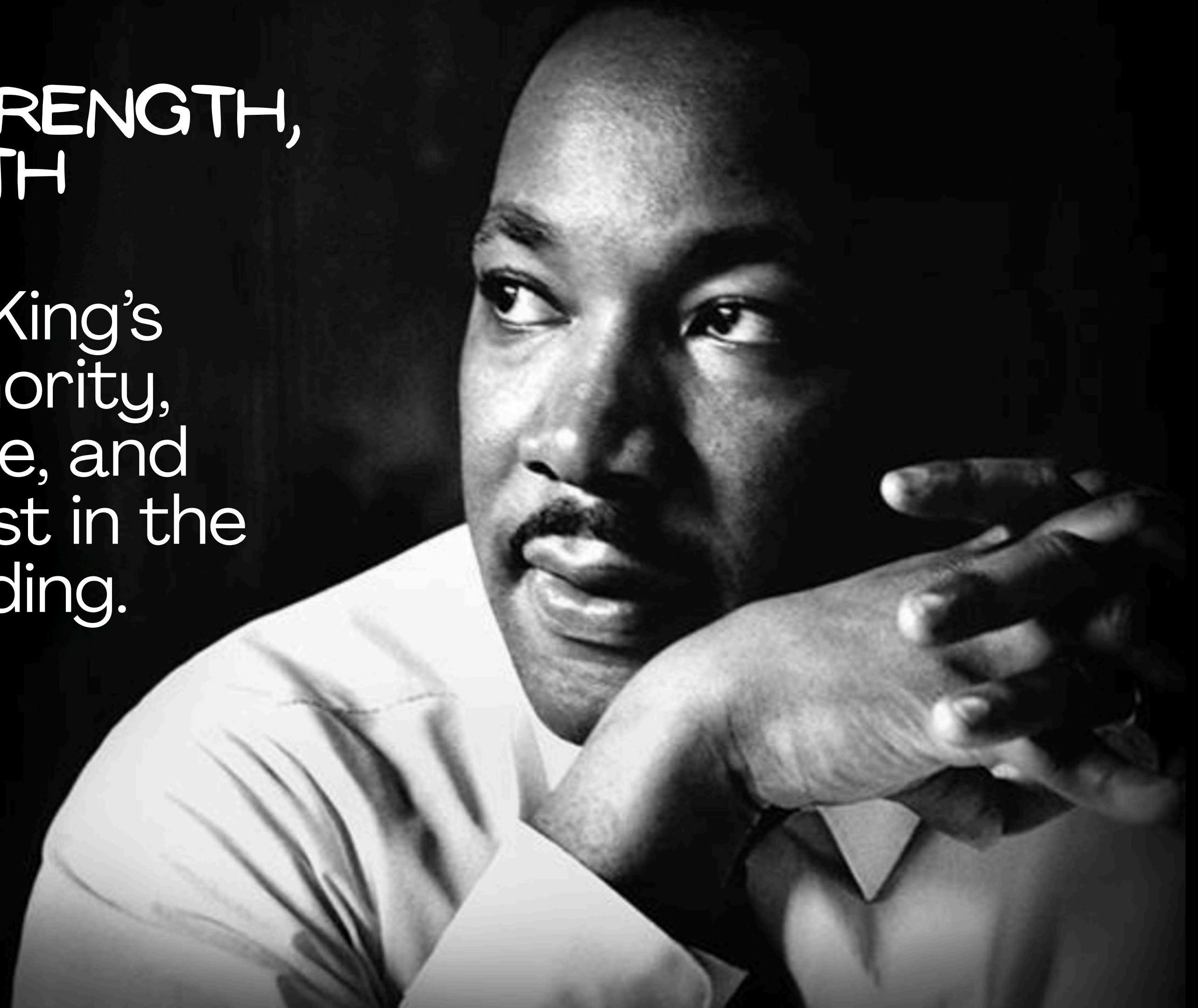

Spiritual Authority Rooted in Love

power of strength is Philip.

POWER OF STRENGTH



Is fortitude, courage, and endurance, the inner capacity to remain steadfast, resilient, and loving in the face of challenge. True strength is not brute force, but quiet, faithful endurance grounded in spiritual understanding.

POWER OF FAITH

Trust in Divine Order and
Possibility

The disciple who represents the
power of Faith is Peter.

The color is royal blue.

Location in the body: The pineal
gland (the “eye of faith”)

POWER OF FAITH

Is not blind belief, but spiritual
perception anchored in divine truth.

The ability to see beyond
appearances, to perceive the good
and to trust the invisible good
unfolding, even before any outer
evidence appears and even when
conditions contradict it. Absolute
belief in and trust in God's presence
and power.



AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

I am established on the rock
of faith.

I trust God's unfailing presence
and power within me.



”DOMINION” AND “DOMAIN”

are derived from the Latin word dominium, which comes from “dominus”, which means “lord” or “master”, and is related to “domus”, meaning “house,” indicating a master or owner of a house.

“Dominion” in scripture and “domain” in modern technology both point to a similar core idea: an area of influence, authority, and stewardship.



DR. KING EMBODIED DOMINION WHEN:

By inner clarity and moral authority,
he responded to a call

He chose nonviolence as the guiding principle

He spoke truth with power





Dr. King embodied Strength when:

He endured imprisonment

He continued after threats, bombings, and
constant danger

He bore the emotional weight of leadership

Dr. King embodied Faith when:

He proclaimed the Dream

He trusted that justice would
prevail

He spoke from hope rather than
despair

DR. KING'S LIFE SHOWS US:

Dominion directed the movement with wisdom and love. **Faith** provided the vision, **Strength** sustained the journey.

By adding Faith and Strength, one sees the mountaintop, the other keeps climbing.

Spiritual transformation always begins within and expresses outward ~ changing lives, communities, and history itself.
