Palm Sunday

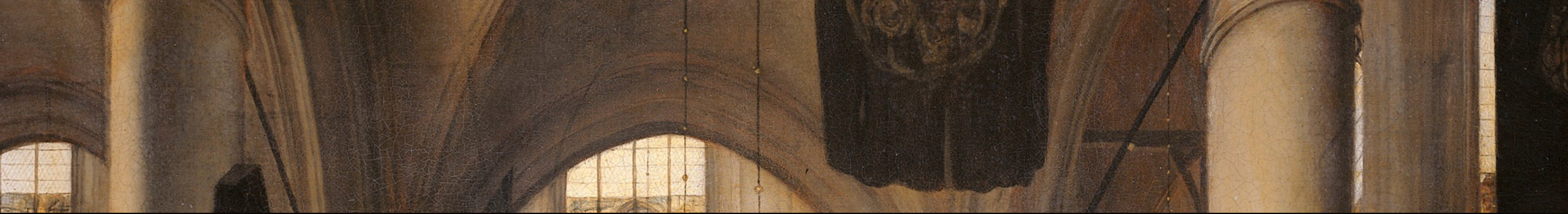
- Marks the beginning of Holy Week.

today?*



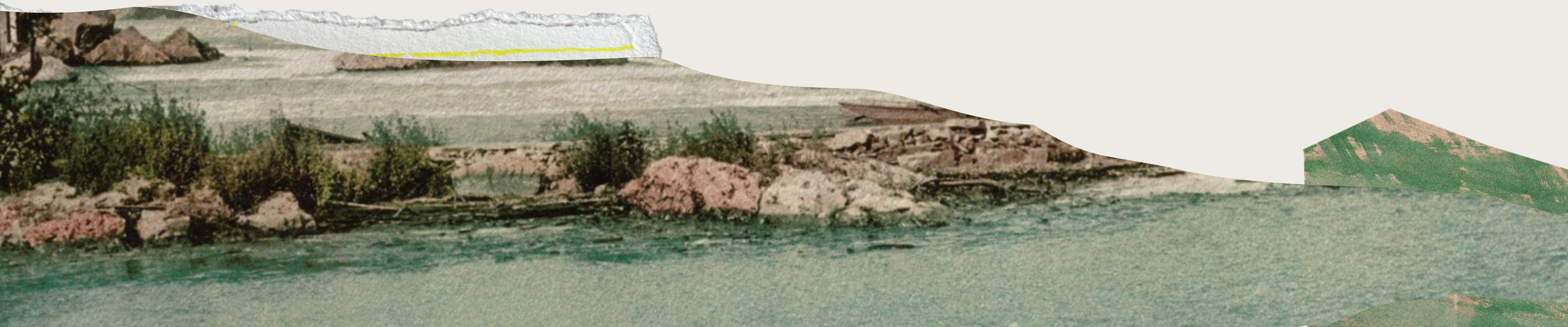
*The triumph is awareness.


So, what are we laying down on the road today?
