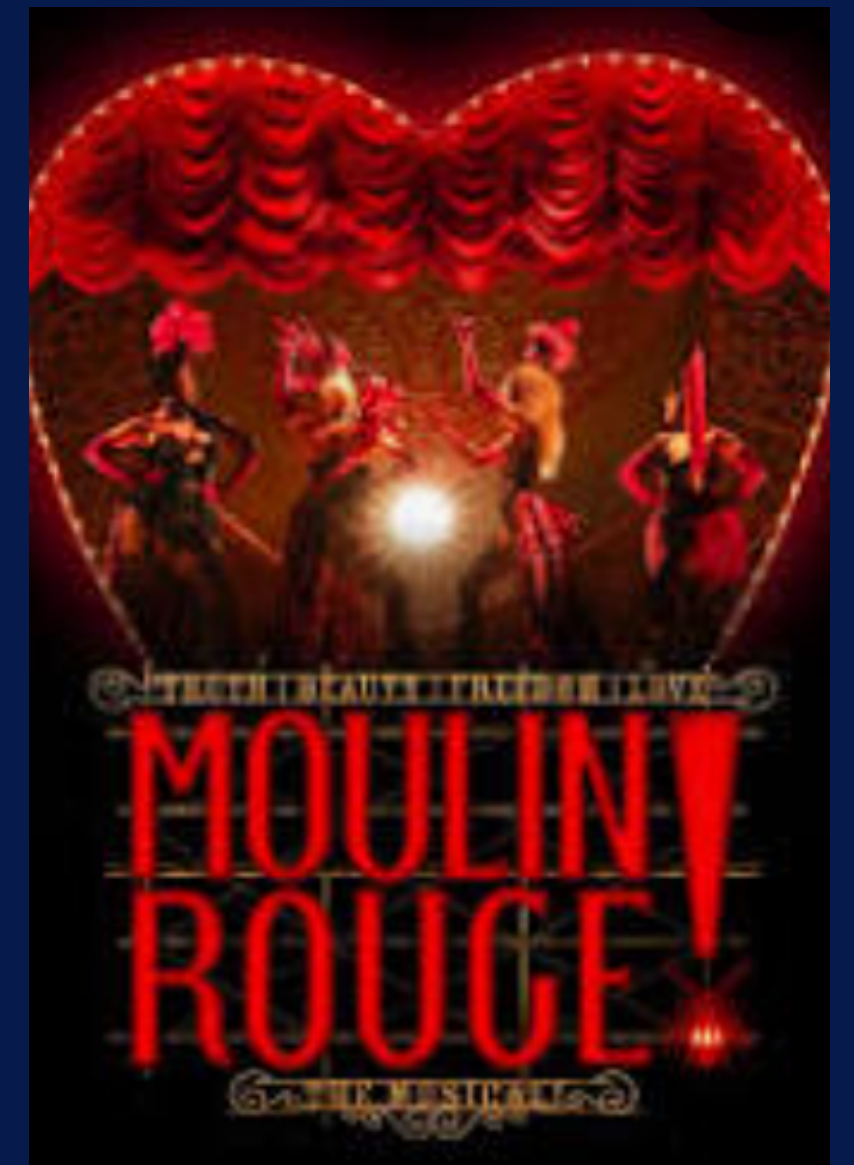

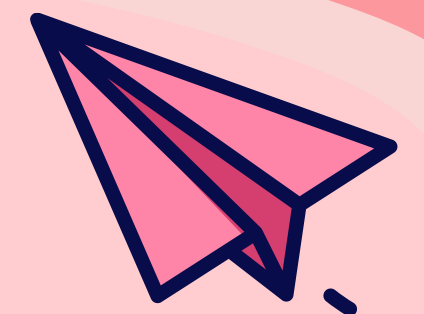

Authenticity is something we uncover.

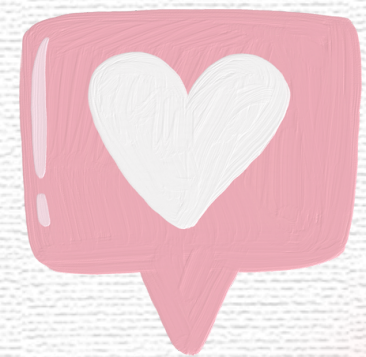


When something lights us up, it often points toward essence.

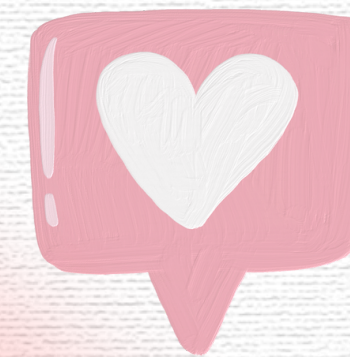
One way we uncover it is by paying attention to what genuinely delights, moves, and nourishes us.

home to ourselves.



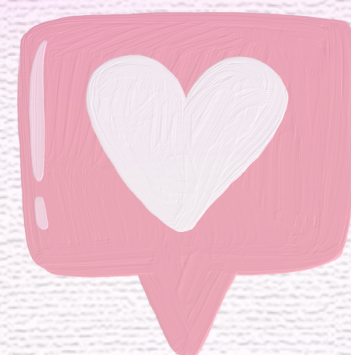
